I went through an unexpected situation which would determine my faith in God and the miracles He can perform. This union had petitioned heaven on my behalf, on days that I wanted to but couldn't.

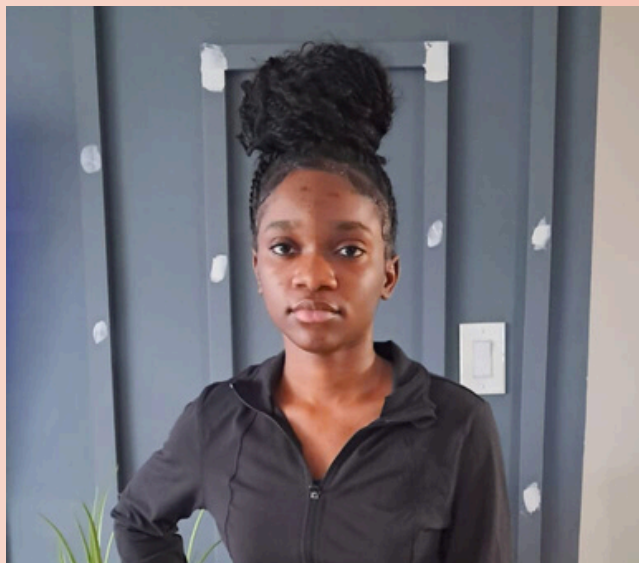

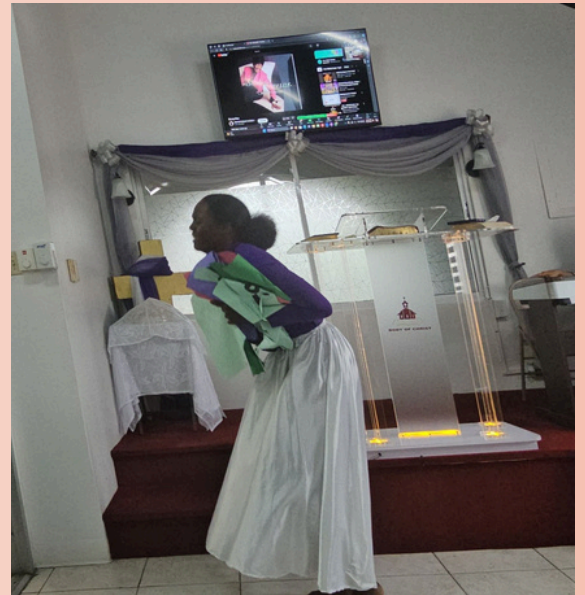

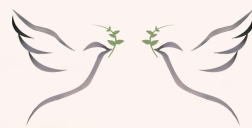
