

### #GROWTH

Over the past year, my life has undergone a profound and deeply personal transformation—one that speaks to the power, compassion, and faithfulness of God. A year ago, I found myself in one of the darkest valleys I have ever walked through. I spent countless days hidden beneath the sheets, isolated in a dark room, weighed down by depression, heartbreak, rejection, and disappointment. My spirit felt fractured, my purpose felt distant, and my hope felt nearly extinguished. I was present in body but absent in spirit, struggling silently and feeling as though life had pressed me beyond my limits. Yet even in that darkness, God never abandoned me.

In His unfailing mercy, He reached into the broken places of my life and began to restore what I thought was beyond healing. Through quiet whispers of comfort, through Scripture that seemed to speak directly to my pain, and through a peace that made no sense in the middle of my storm, God slowly lifted me up. Christ became my light, my strength, and my compass. He reminded me that the place of brokenness is often the place where His greatest work begins.

I am profoundly grateful for Apostle Williams and my Body of Christ family, who have been a tremendous source of support, guidance, and encouragement. Even though I have not met them in person—being here in New York while they are in Jamaica—they have made me feel deeply connected, embraced, and spiritually covered. Distance has not diminished the love, unity, or fellowship I feel. Their prayers, their words, and their genuine care reached me exactly when I needed it most, reminding me that in God's family, we are never truly alone.

Today, by the grace of God, I am standing stronger. I am more focused, more grounded, and more aligned with the path God is leading me on. I am learning to trust His direction, even when it challenges me, and to walk boldly in the purpose He has placed within me. The heartbreak, rejection, and disappointments that once threatened to break me have now become the very testimonies God is using to shape me.

This is my #Growth—a journey from darkness into light, from despair into hope, from isolation into community, and from confusion into purpose. I am not who I was a year ago, and I give God all the glory for the healing, restoration, and new strength He has given me.
